POLICIES AND PROCEDURES REPRINTED FROM THE 2021 ACADEMY PROSPECTUS IN REGARDS TO EVENTS

COMPETITION ENTRY FEES - ALL LAAG STUDENTS:-

If your child is eligible and ready to attend a competition, entry forms will be sent out approximately 8 weeks prior to the competition to inform parents of all the particulars. All Competitions have a “closing date” for entries to be received at our office. This is generally 4 – 6 weeks prior to the competition date.

- To be eligible to attend a competition all Invoices due to the Academy must be up to date and all competition entry fees must be forwarded to our office **by the closing date**.
- Late entries **ARE NOT** accepted for all G.Q, G.A, & INTER-CLUB competitions.
- For Academy “in house” events 1 weeks grace is given after the closing date then no further entries can be accepted.
- Entry Fees are not refundable if your child pulls out of the competition after the closing date.
- In the event your child is injured or sick & unable to participate a refund (less 20%) will apply up to 2 weeks after the event on receipt of a medical certificate at the Academy Office.

For gymnast’s training 4 hours or more per week:-

Competition Entry fees are determined and charged by the organising body of the event e.g. Club, State or National Gymnastics Association. Payment of your child’s competition entry fees **does not cover the costs involved** for Academy coaches & judges to be in attendance at these events. Our coaching & judging staff are paid employee’s (not volunteers) and as such weekend events & competitions come at a considerable cost to the program. In an effort to minimise the costs involved for the parents a “competition replaces training” policy is utilised i.e. one training session will be cancelled for each event attended. The training session that will be cancelled is at the coaches’ discretion and parents will be notified well in advance of any such cancellation. Classes cancelled due to these events are not considered missed lessons and will not be credited or made up.

In addition to this policy a small levy per competition is charged for competitions other than the Academy in-house events to further assist with the significant costs involved for the Program to staff and administrate these events.

Parents need to be aware on many occasions in the gymnastics year coaches are required to attend lengthy competition sessions for a very small number of gymnasts due to the many age divisions provided at individual competitions. Coaches are frequently employed to be on the competition floor for 1 or 2 gymnasts. Judges need to attend every session of each level irrespective of whether we have gymnasts in every session or not. If the program chose to utilise a “user pays” system for competitions the costs to parents would be considerably increased.

• **TEAMS PARENT / COACH - MEETING WEEK**

In March/April of each year our Coaching staff conducts parent coach meetings for our Team Gymnasts. The purpose of these meetings is to meet with the parents to discuss what we have on the agenda for their child for the coming year.

• **TEAMS NIGHT OF EXCELLENCE**

Our Annual Awards night for teams is conducted once a year generally towards the end of the year or the competitive season. Please note any lesson cancelled or reduced in time to accommodate this special event will not be credited or made up.
